

## Supply List

*Avoid items displaying words, pictures, TV shows, and slogans that are not indicative of a Biblical life-style. Graphics, emblems, and slogans promoting rock groups, rock songs, grotesque pictures of space or similar creatures, crude manners, trolls, Power Rangers, Super Power friends or enemies, Harry Potter, or similar entities are not in harmony with Biblical principles, and may not be displayed on items brought to school.*

Supplies may need to be replenished throughout the school year. Other items may be needed on a class-by-class basis.

### Kindergarten (K4 & K5) \*

- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 bottle anti-bacterial soap

- 2 erasers – *pink* (Do not label)
- 1 pair scissors - Fiskars h4 blunt

- 1 Bible- KJV only – preferably large print

\* **Performance Attire - to be worn at all school programs unless otherwise instructed:**

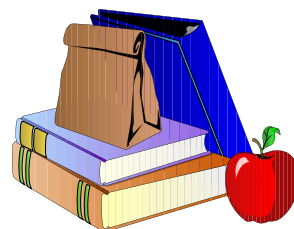
**Boys - Black dress pants
